Since [Tiki3](#), there is a new [PluginWebservice](#) to manage web services, and an admin panel to set up the feature.

## Admin interface

### Webservice Registration

*Discover and register web services to allow direct use in wiki pages.*



Enter the URL of a web services returning either JSON or YAML. Parameters can be specified by enclosing a name between percentage signs. For example: %name%. %service% and %template% are reserved keywords and cannot be used.
