

Dynamic Content System

The Dynamic Content System (DCS) allows you to edit blocks of HTML code or text from an admin screen and display the block in any Tiki template or user module. Updating the block content will update the template. You can also create block content by date, storing several blocks to be displayed at future dates. This simple system adds a lot of flexibility to Tiki; you can display anything you like anywhere in the screen and you can set up areas that can be changed or that change automatically according to time.

The DCS can be used, for example:

- To display a quote in the top bar or a user module
- To display news in a user module
- To announce products, chats, news at a specific time
- To announce an event
- To display sport results or sports information
- to add customized Google maps to your Wiki pages
- Anything!

Dynamic Content, which displays pre-created content where the DSC tag is placed in template files and/or modules, is not the same as [Dynamic Variable](#), which is an edit-in-place feature for use in wiki pages.

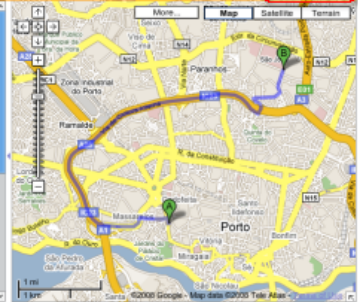

1. Head north on R. de Júlio Dinis toward R. da Piedade 0.1 km
2. Turn left at Praça da Galiza 85 m
3. Continue on R. do Campo Alegre 0.3 km
4. Take the ramp onto Via Panorâmica 0.4 km
5. Continue on R. de Entre Campos 0.5 km
6. Take the ramp to IC23 0.1 km
7. Slight right at IC23 0.3 km
8. Take the exit toward Portal Paranhos 0.3 km
9. Turn left at R. de Faria Guimarães 0.3 km
10. Slight right at R. da Igreja de Paranhos 44 m
11. Turn right at Largo da Igreja de
