Overview

Jitsi Desktop is an open source instant messaging client, which is different than Jitsi Meet

To Access

From the Connect page, click the **Jitsi** tab.

Jitsi Info

Since Tiki 12.3 and Tiki13, Tiki has a light integration to help with deployment of the Jitsi desktop client in organizations by providing a URL for Jitsi provisioning.

You can use this to centrally manage configurations for all Jitsi clients in your organizations. Examples:

- All users to join a group chat
- Deactivate some Jitsi features
- etc.

At this time, \${username} and \${password} are a simple pass-through to auto-configure the accounts.
