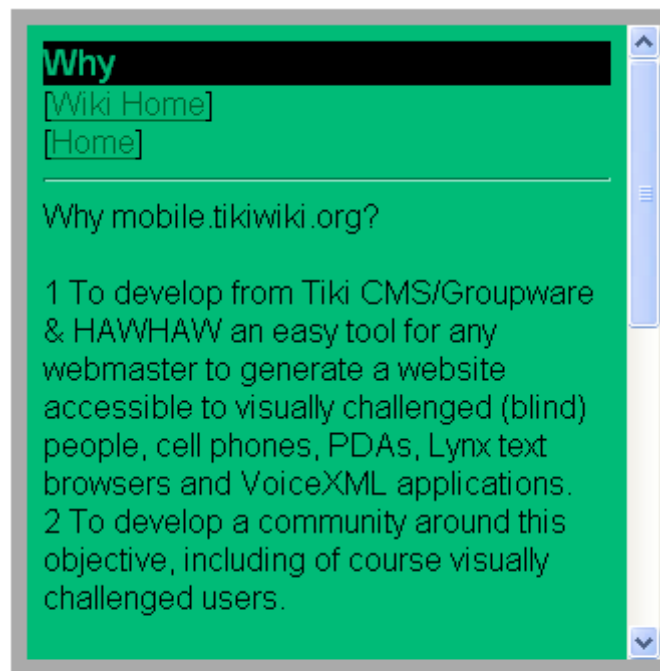

This is how a user will see a MobileTiki enabled site through the computer web browser:
