**Mailman** is free software for managing electronic mail discussion and e-newsletter lists. Mailman is integrated with the web, making it easy for users to manage their accounts and for list owners to administer their lists. Mailman supports built-in archiving, automatic bounce processing, content filtering, digest delivery, spam filters, and more. ### Package Config

#### Configure services *mailman*

You may want to add that line into your apache conf if you use rewrite rules  
: RewriteRule ^/int([0-9]+) /tiki-integrator.php?repID=\$1 [QSA,L]  
For this feature works, the apache user has to be granted the permission to execute the list\_lists mailman command. You can use visudo and add  
: www-data ALL= NOPASSWD: /usr/sbin/list\_lists
