

Transfer Field Type

This field type implements the [Element Plus Transfer](#) component and leverages [SortableJS](#) to provide a re-ordering feature for items in the list.

It's used across all fields that support multi-valued items, which are:

USAGE

1. RELATED FIELD OPTIONS

The Transfer field type is accompanied by a set of field options that can be used to customize the behavior of the component:

Name

Filterable

Filter Placeholder

Source List Title

Target List Title

Ordering

Description

Render a search box allowing the user to filter items within the list

Placeholder text for the filter input

Label for the left list

Label for the right list

Enable the re-ordering feature of items in the list

Type	Default
yes/no	no
text	Enter keyword
text	List
text	Selected
yes/no	no

2. EXAMPLE

Let's see an example using the Multiselect field.
We have to edit the field input type option to set it to **Transfer**.
