ometimes, email clients or web pages can generate links that look like: "*Pagename.*", "*PageName)*", "*PageName.*)", c "*PageName,*" and lead to a "*Page not found*" error.

Fortunately, Tiki is smart enough to handle this, thanks to an exciting feature: "URL Suffix Cleaner".

What it does

Concretely, when this feature is enabled, if a requested page is not found, it tries to remove one or two characters from the end of the URL to see if it gets a perfect match with an existing working page, and if so, it redirects the user to that

How to use

As Tiki gives us the possibility to use only what we want, the URL Suffix Cleaner feature must be activated before we can use it


Steps to activate

- From your System menu click on Settings (You must be an admin)
- \cdot Under the dropdown select Control Panels







 Scroll down a little bit to find the URL Suffix Cleaner feature, and check the box to activate it


