## How to access the database from within a Wiki Plugin?

There are three ways to access the DB:

- 1. **\$tikilib->query(\$sql, \$attributes);** This method allows you to utilize any functionality your MySQL username is allowed to use. it returns an AdoDB object.
- 2. PluginSQL
- 3. PluginDBReport

## **Using JQuery**

JQuery gets included at the bottom of the page, so it isn't accessible in your plugins' template. To access JQuery:

- 1. Make sure you have the global variable \$headerlib defined.
- Add your JS with \$headerlib->add\_js( your js code );

You won't have the \$() syntax. Use \$jq() instead.
