But it looks like these are just the files in the `templates/` and `templates/modules` directories, and not any theme-specific template versions. So there's nothing to see that can't be seen in a standard Tiki download package. (Template editing is turned off at `themes.tw.o`.)

The template files for the Mittwoch theme will be in a file gallery at `themes.tw.o` when they are ready.
